Entry requirements

You will need to complete a maths introduction course to ensure this course is at a suitable level for your needs.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to take notes so bring along your preferred tools such as pen/paper or electronic device. An A4 ringbinder folder and calculator will also be essential.
