English L1-2 Bridging Course



Course overview

This course follows on from the English Level 1 course.

This is a course designed for learners who have completed a level 1 Functional Skills English qualification and want to gain the skills and knowledge to progress onto Functional skills English level 2.

You will continue to improve your reading, writing, and speaking and listening skills whilst working towards a functional skills qualification.

You will learn in a supportive and welcoming environment, with guidance from the tutor. You will work on your own and with other learners on different tasks, so as well as developing your English skills you will be practicing life and work skills such as decision-making, prioritising, collaborating and independence. You will be expected to complete homework to reinforce and extend your skills outside of class time.

What will I study?

On this course you will focus on topics such as:

- Planning, drafting and correcting letters, reports, e-mails etc.
- Using the correct language and format for different types of writing
- Using imagery and descriptive techniques in writing
- · Using spelling, grammar and punctuation correctly
- Comparing information, ideas and opinions in different texts
- Reading and understanding a range of specialist words in context
- Writing consistently and accurately in complex sentences, using paragraphs where appropriate
- Following and understanding discussions and making contributions relevant to the situation and the subject
