### Course overview

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Join us for a journey through literature.

Book club is open to everyone, from those who can read simple texts and want to improve their reading skills, to those who already enjoy reading and would like to read and talk about a book in a small, friendly group.

### What will I study?

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The course will include the following:-

- Reading familiar tales and new works
- Recognising the basic elements needed to tell a good story.
- Encouraging discussion about themes, narratives and characters
- Discussion on writing style, author's intent and comparing texts

### Assessment method

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Various assessment methods, including on-line and paper-based assessments, individual, group work and communication activities, and given feedback on your progress. Throughout the course you will also receive feedback from your tutor and learn the skills to self-reflect and evaluate your progress.

### Entry requirements

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You do not need any previous experience or formal qualifications, but you will need to be able to read story samples.

## What do I need for my class?

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You will need to take notes so you will need to have your preferred tools such as pen/paper or electronic device. An A4 ringbinder folder will also be essential for storing paper notes.
