

Family Learning Maths KS2 SATs Support for Parents

Course overview

This course is designed for parents/caregivers of KS2 children. Because everything appears to be taught differently these days, it is natural for any parent/carer to want to regain confidence in their ability to support their child. This course will help you improve your mathematical skills and gain confidence to support your children as they prepare for their end-of-year KS2 SATs.

What will I study?

Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about the courses and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with the course.

During the course you will:

- Be clearer about what numeracy skills are taught in school and how you can support your children,
- Be introduced to several methods and strategies to help your children when they get ready to sit their SATs exams.
- Be able to increase your knowledge of math and develop your own mathematical skills.
- Improve your numeracy skills and increase your confidence when helping your children with their homework.

Assessment method

You will initially be assessed when you join the course. You will also complete various in class activities and homework which will allow you and the teacher to monitor your progress on regular basis.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/carers who wish to develop their own math skills to be able to support their KS2 children. In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with the course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper or any other note taking device for this session. You will be given the opportunity to access our online learning platform, for this you will need to have access to a mobile phone or any other electronic device.

Key information

This course will take place at Parsloes our College Dagenham Site. You are advised, and will be supported, to install our learning platform Teams on your phone or any other electronic device. You will be able to access all the course resources and communicate with your teacher via Teams. In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.

At the end of your course, you will be invited to attend the Family learning celebration event at the college, where you will receive progression advice and your course completion certificate.
