

Family Learning: PHONICS-EXPLORING ENGLISH PRONUNCIATION

Course overview

Effective pronunciation is essential for clear communication in English, particularly for learners of English as a Second or Other Language (ESOL). This course offers ESOL learners an opportunity to explore and improve their English pronunciation through targeted activities and practice sessions. Participants will gain confidence in their speaking abilities and enhance their overall English language skills.

What will I study?

Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about this course and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with this course.

You will:

- Become more familiar with English sounds, including consonants, vowels, and combinations of two vowels.
- Practise correct mouth and tongue placement for English sounds.
- Participate in pair and group activities to practise pronunciation in context.
- Learn how the way we pronounce sentences may change their meaning.

Assessment method

You will initially be assessed when you join the course. You will also complete various in class activities and homework which will allow you and the teacher to monitor your progress on regular basis.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/carers who wish to develop their English language communication skills. In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with the course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper, or any other note-taking device for this session. If you have access to a mobile phone or any other electronic device, you will be encouraged to access Teams our teaching platform. Please speak to your teacher if you have issues with online access.

Key information

This course will take place at the college. You are advised, and will be supported, to install our learning platform Teams on your phone or any other electronic device. You will be able to access all the course resources and communicate with your teacher via Teams. In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.

At the end of your course, you will be invited to attend the Family learning celebration event at the college, when you will receive progression advice and your course completion certificate.
