

Family Learning: Developing Language for Employability

Course overview

The "Developing Language for Employability " course is designed to empower English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) learners with the language skills necessary to enhance their employability prospects in English-speaking work environments. This course focuses on developing language and communication skills for the job market.

What will I study?

Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about this course and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with this ESOL for Parents Course.

You will:

- Learn vocabulary and language structures commonly used in various professional settings.
- Improve job interview skills, including CV writing, cover letter composition, and interview preparation.
- Gain confidence in expressing ideas, opinions, and questions in professional contexts.

Assessment method

You will initially be assessed when you join the course. You will also complete various in class activities and homework which will allow you and the teacher to monitor your progress on regular basis.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/carers who wish to develop their English language communication skills. In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with the course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper, or any other note-taking device for this session. If you have access to a mobile phone or any other electronic device, you will be encouraged to access Teams our teaching platform. Please speak to your teacher if you have issues with online access.

Key information

This course is a progression opportunity for the learners who completed an ESOL for Parents Course. You are advised, and will be supported, to install our learning platform Teams on your phone or any other electronic device. You will be able to access all the course resources and communicate with your teacher via Teams. In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.

At the end of your course, you will be invited to attend the Family learning celebration event at the college, when you will receive progression advice and your course completion certificate.
