## Wellbeing: Learn to Read a Sewing Pattern



#### **Course overview**

One you are familiar with your sewing machine many people want to go on to create more complex items which require a pattern. Sewing patters often have notations and option which are hard to understand. In this workshop you will learn to read a sewing pattern and understand what the symbols and different lines mean. You will use this knowledge to sew a practice item.

### What will I study?

You will:

- Identify the meaning / instruction of different pattern notations
- · Recap the basics of safely using a sewing machine
- Use a pattern to cut and sew a practice item

#### **Assessment method**

You will participate in discussions, Q&A and sewing activities and will receive support from the tutor throughout.

This course is open to all. The ability to follow instructions give in English is essential.
