This course is for those who can already use a sewing machine or who have completed one of our first steps courses (meet the sewing machine or get started with machine sewing). It will develop your skills and confidence to enable you to become more adventurous in your sewing.

What will I study?

You will:

- Be able to correctly adjust thread tension
- Be able to correctly select and use a range of stitch styles
- Create different seam types
- Use some of the features of a sewing machine
- Identify when to use different feet and needle sizes

Assessment method

You will participate in activities, brief discussions and Q&A and receive support from the tutor throughout.

This course is open to all. Only one child per parent.
